Footnotes

BIGASMAR rated off the pace, was patient on the turn while angling out from two to six-wide, was set down upper stretch, took command near midstretch and drew off under a hand ride. GRAPES, in touch, came three to six-wide through the turn, bid at the top of the stretch, led briefly but was headed midstretch. SILVER BORREGO, in touch, chased four to seven-wide on the turn then finished determinedly. RUNAWAY MY WAY showed early speed, chased up close on the turn, challenged at the top of the stretch, dueled briefly and flattened out in deep stretch. TRAJECTORY'S DREAM showed speed, dueled on the turn then tired in the final furlong. WHY DAT raced off the pace, was hustled three to seven-wide through the turn then evened out in the stretch. OCCASIO, used early, forced the pace, bid into the turn, dueled from the rail then tired a furlong out. QUINNER'S CIRCLE stalked to the turn then faded and lacked a closing response.
