TREND stalked the pace, closed three-wide into the stretch, took the lead midstretch, drew clear and held under a drive. SIR MCINTYRE raced off the pace, closed into the turn, chased three and four-wide and was all out through the stretch. STUNNING SPLIT raced off the pace, chased five-wide into the stretch, finished gamely and was best of the rest. DOUBLE DOUBLE, prominent early ,dueled from midturn, wore down that rival but was passed midstretch. BATTLE HARBOUR, well back early, saved ground, was roused at the top of the stretch but never reached contention. WARRENS HEIGHTS raced forwardly, forced the pace, dueled from midturn then yielded upper stretch. FRANKLY stalked the pace, was hustled along the rail on the turn but had no response in the stretch. D'OTHERSIDEOFDCOIN was always well back and lacked a rally.
