INDIAN EVENING stalked the pace from well back, angled two to four-wide and closed fast late turn, challenged upper stretch, quickly took command and drew off under a hand ride. LOCKOUT settled off the pace, closed along the rail late turn, bid inside the pacesetter upper stretch but was outkicked by the winner and chased to the end. OCALA SON, prominent early, pressed the pace on the main track through backstretch and turn, chased three-wide into the stretch but was no match for the top two and evened out. BUONGIORNO JOHNNY took a short lead on the main track, set the pace under pressure from OCALA SON, was collared upper stretch, yielded quickly and tired. DON'T SEND A BOY, rated early, was hustled from off the pace on the turn but was never in contention.
