CONGOR BAY settled off the pace, came two and three-wide through the turn, bumped with his stable mate upper stretch, responded when asked, rallied and was up in time under a drive. KID CANUCK stalked the pace, chased in the stretch, bid midstretch and gained a short lead then failed to hold the winner safe in deep stretch. LOVEYOUALLTHETIME dueled from the rail, drove clear at the top of the stretch, was engaged midstretch and gave way grudgingly. EVEN settled off the pace, saved ground then finished gamely along the rail. BOGUE CHITTO raced off the pace, angled two to four-wide on the turn, bumped with his stable mate upper stretch then evened out in the late stages. DANIEL BE GOOD dueled, yielded at the top of the stretch and tired. BENT ATTORNEY stalked the pace, came three and four-wide through the turn, chased upper stretch and tired. OCTAVO stalked from between rivals then lacked a closing response.
