EMPIRE SPRING stalked the pace, chased three and four-wide on the far turn, bid upper stretch, drew off quickly and finished under a hand ride. TRIPPI'S SAILOR, rated early, closed on the backstretch, bid into the turn, dueled, gained a short lead led briefly upper stretch, was passed and chased to the wire. WILD STRIKE forced the pace, chased on the far turn then evened out in the stretch. KARLIE'S HOLIDAY raced in midpack, was hustled four-wide on the far turn but never reached contention. GREENAPPLE MARTINI stalked the pace, was hustled three-wide on the far turn then flattened out in the stretch. KALAMBAKA QUEEN set a pressured pace, dueled on the far turn then tired upper stretch. RUSTED THROUGH settled well back early and trailed throughout.
