Footnotes

RIDDELL'S CREEK was void of early speed, swung wide at the 3/8 pole, closed with a rush 8 wide to get up in the final strides. CERTAINLY CLASSIC was void of early speed, split horses in upper stretch, came outside of the leaders and closed fast, just missed. GALLYN'S STAR stalked the early pace, loomed boldly 3 wide at the 3/8 pole, gained command in mid stretch, but couldn't sustain the bid. BACARDI BOYS was unhurried in the early going, between horses 3 wide in the turn, split foes at the 1/4 and closed willingly. CAYUSE was in hand while stalking the pace, saved ground into the turn, boxed at the 1/4 pole, went between horses in the stretch, then weakened. IDENT stalked the pace between horses, blocked at the 3/8 pole and steadied, found room in the stretch but lacked a late response. SATILLO RIVER dueled for the early lead on the inside, then tired in the stretch. SING AMERICA was allowed to settle, went between horses around the turn, weakened on the rail in the stretch. GOLDEN TAI settled in mid pack in the early going outside of rivals, closed the gap in upper stretch 6 wide, tired in the late going. TAOS was allowed to settle off the lead, was 5 wide around the turn, but lacked a late rally. IRISH FURY was unhurried on the rail, went between horses at the 3/8 pole, never made a rally. SAM LORD was allowed to settle between horses, failed to respond when asked at the 3/8 pole, and dropped back in the stretch. VALID N BOLD saved ground into the turn to no avail, was never a threat. SULTRY SWING was away alertly, pressed the pace in the early going, faded in the stretch.
