UNCLE WOGER broke sharply and dueled for the early lead, drew clear around the turn, much the best in the stretch, crossed the wire in hand. HIDDEN POCKET was off slowly and allowed to settle, rallied between horses, but was no match for the winner. REGAL CLANCY was unhurried early, roused 4 wide around the turn, finished evenly in the stretch. LAZOR ART showed good early speed while dueling inside, then faded stretch. ICE ADVICE stalked the pace in the four path, failed to respond around the turn, dropped back in the stretch.
