MEMA'S TURNING RED was in hand on an unchallenged lead in the backstretch, responded well in the drive and widened the margin, was then under a hand ride to the wire. CRYPTIC RESPONSE was well rated along the rail, saved ground through the turn and was shuffled back, then roused in the stretch and finished with a belated bid. GERONIMO'S JOY was unhurried early then blocked at the quarter pole, altered course in the drive and closed fast well off the rail. BRANCHBURY was allowed to settle on the rail, closed the gap in the turn but was blocked in mid stretch, split horses in the final furlong and finished with a late gain. BAR U MOKWA was unhurried early three wide but failed to respond in the stretch. MISSY IN ACTION stalked the early pace three wide in the backstretch then dropped back in the drive. MATILDA DANCER was in hand stalking the early pace between horses then weakened in the stretch. HOLY MISS was unhurried early three wide, raced between horses around the turn but lacked a late response. GOODEVE was unhurried early four wide then dropped back in the turn.
