Footnotes

OUT WELL was unhurried early just off the rail, swung wide on the turn and entered the stretch four wide, loomed boldly outside of RUBY TANGO in the drive and wore that one down under strong steady pressure. The latter set the early pace in hand, opened a clear lead on the turn, continued strong in the drive, but faltered in the late going and gave way. VALID WIRE was allowed to settle just off the rail, roused three wide on the turn and made a mild bid, but flattened out in the drive. HEYHOWWHATDOYOUKNOW was allowed to settle inside of rivals, closed the gap approaching the far turn, but was steadied for most of the turn and never a threat. PRINCESS REMAYAA was unhurried early between horses and never a threat. ESPRIT was hustled along pressing the early pace inside of rivals then tired. NOBODY BOTHERS ME was unhurried early in the three path and never rallied.
