SCREEN HAPPY sprinted to the early lead and opened a clear advantage in hand, turned away rivals on the turn and opened a clear lead again in the drive and was under mild urging to the wire. ETERNALLY YOURS was hustled along outside of rivals, closed the gap three wide on the turn, but was no match for the winner. SOUTHERN PEAK was allowed to settle between horses, roused entering the stretch and finished with a mild bid. SEARCH FOR BLUE chased the winner from the three path, closed the gap on the turn, but got tired in the stretch and dropped back. SOUTHERN SWEET was void of early speed from off the rail and failed to respond in the stretch. STEPHANIE'S WAGER was unhurried early in the two path and never a factor. PRETTYASPUPPIES was void of early speed and outrun. DALIA'S WHIRL raced close up inside of rivals, then tired in the stretch and dropped back.
