CLASSIC GRATA was in hand three wide in the early going, dueled outside of EXPECTED TEMPER on the turn, roused entering the stretch and edged clear in the early going under intermittent urging. EXPECTED TEMPER vied for the early lead between horses, then edged clear in upper stretch, but could not hold off the winner and gave way in the final strides. T C MAIDEN was hustled along pressing the early pace inside of rivals, then weakened in the stretch and dropped back. KAIN OF GOLD angled to the rail in the early going, rallied on the turn while saving ground, then flattened out and dropped back. WEST OF HOUSTON was close up between horses, but was checked in the backstretch and dropped back. KENDI LOU was close up widest in the early going, continued four wide on the turn and weakened in the drive. LOVELY QUEEN pressed the early pace between horses, then dropped back on the turn. EMERALD HILLS was hustled along four wide, then dropped back on the turn in a dull effort. CAMPAIGN PROMISE was void of early speed and never rallied. ARCTIC SNOW stumbled at the start and lost the jockey.
