Footnotes

CANADIAN WISH raced midpack between horses, closed angling from five to seven-wide late turn, rallied, bid midstretch and drove clear. TEQUILA MAX raced off the pace, closed six-wide into the far turn, chased hard and was all out in the stretch. HOLY SCHNEIKIES, in range, closed five-wide on the turn, bid midturn, led at the top of the stretch but gave way grudgingly in the late stages. OUTOFTHEDEPHTS stalked the pace, was checked in tight between rivals at the top of the stretch, rallied towards the inside but evened out late. A KISS IN THE PARK stalked the pace, closed late turn then evened out in the stretch. FEDERAL COURT, in range, aimed towards the rail late turn and challenged at the top of the stretch but failed to sustain the bid. BREATHITT, off a step slowly, raced off the pace, closed under a ride on the far turn, was game in the stretch but never threatened. HIP HIP SINHA forced the pace, bid into the far turn, was passed midturn, chased to the stretch and tired. MONTANA MEMORIES, rated midpack, raced two and three-wide on the far turn but dropped back then failed to menace. SANDICAT, rated in range, dropped back on the far turn, was roused at the top of the stretch but had no response. KENTAVROS settled off the pace, was under strong rousing late turn but showed no response. CHAIN REACTION led early, set a pressured pace, was headed midturn and tired.
