KING OF THE SWAMP, in range, bid into the far turn but was outkicked, chased then rebid in deep stretch and went by under a drive. SEPTEMBER SQUARE raced off the pace, closed between rivals late backstretch, cut to the rail and drove to the lead at the turn, opened up and was hustled along but failed to stay in the late stages. KILLDARES PROSPECT raced off the pace, was hustled three to six-wide on the turn, finished determinedly and was gaining fast. PIRATE'S LEGEND raced off the pace, was hustled seven-wide late turn and rallied gamely. NOT SO GRIEM raced midpack, came three and four-wide through the turn, chased into the stretch but evened out with a sixteenth to run. SIR ADIE broke inward and was grabbed, raced off the pace, was hustled angled from four to seven-wide on the turn then finished gamely in vain. TRAJECTORY'S DREAM raced midpack, came four and five-wide on the far turn, chased into the stretch but flattened out. FRIDAY ON MY MIND hopped at the start, raced well back, closed three-wide late turn, was blocked briefly at the head of the stretch then showed a mild late run. BY CHANCE TO DREAM led early, was headed on the first turn and stalked the pace, bid into the turn, was outkicked and faded. HAT TRICK KID, in range, came two to four-wide through the far turn, chased into the stretch and tired. HUMBER VALLEY raced midpack, closed late backstretch, saved ground under a ride on the far turn then tired in the stretch. HARRIER led midway of the first turn, set the pace, was headed at the far turn, chased briefly and tired.
