Footnotes

RIDING THE RIVER stalked the pace, bid midway of the far turn, dueled, shook clear a furlong out, drifted in and out from the whip but prevailed under a drive. YOUR ROUND set a pressured pace, dueled along the rail from midturn then gave way only grudgingly in the final furlong. RED LEADER raced midpack, was hustled four-wide on the far turn then finished under a determined drive. RESERVOIR raced off the pace, closed two-wide on the far turn then finished gamely. CATCH THE LUCK settled off the pace, was hustled angling from two to five-wide on the far turn but failed to menace. PORT STANLEY raced off the pace, was roused three-wide late turn but never reached contention. TIERRA DEL TIGRE stalked the pace, moved up to forced the issue on the backstretch, bid between foes midturn, dueled, then tired upper stretch.
