RUBY TANGO was unhurried early outside of rivals, made a quick move four wide on the turn and assumed command in mid stretch, continued strong in the final furlong and drew off under steady pressure. COUSIN CHARLOTTE showed good early speed and dueled inside of MYWAY WEST, battled gamely with that one and got up for place. The latter dueled outside of COUSIN CHARLOTTE in the early going, continued dueling to deep stretch before weakening in the final strides. MICAYLA'S PEACH was void of early speed while saving ground, then finished with a mild rally in the stretch. DANCING SNOWFLAKE was allowed to settle just off the rail, then roused three wide on the turn, but was never a threat. PURE TRANQUILITY was close up inside of rivals and lacked a late response. INTIMATE MUSIC stalked the early pace three wide, then faded in the stretch. MATTER OF JUSTICE was hustled along and void of early speed in the three path and outrun. AQUITAINE ELEANOR was void of early speed and outrun.
