MORNING PRAYERS led early, set the pace and widened under a drive. TEJANO THE QUEEN, well back early, closed three-wide on the turn but could not gain in the stretch. ONE MECK OF A LADY, hustled along four-wide on the turn, evened out in the stretch. LAP AND TAP stalked the pace, closed along the rail on the turn then evened out. SWEET AFTON, close early, was hustled from between foes on the turn then lacked a rally. NEWS AT NOON dropped back along the rail, was roused on the turn but showed no response. SEVENTEEN DAISIES broke alertly, stalked the pace, was hard ridden between foes on the turn and tired.
