WHISKY SWISH, unhurried, saved ground, closed into the stretch then angled out, was full of run and got up late. KICK'EM JENNY forced the pace late backstretch, dropped back at the turn, moved from the rail to three-wide and chased, bid at the 1/4 pole, vied into the stretch, had a slight advantage to deep stretch and failed to hold the winner safe. SHEBA forced the pace, vied into the turn, stayed gamely inside her rival to deep stretch and weakened. FOXS CONSORT saved ground, closed late turn, angled out upper stretch, was game but hung. BOX OFFICE LAUNCH stalked, bid four-wide at the top of the stretch but failed to sustain the drive. RUCKUS IN THE BAY raced off the pace, was roused three-wide late turn but never threatened. BELLE OF ASCOT broke alertly, set a pressured pace, vied into the turn then tired late turn. KEEPING DA FAITH refused at the gate. A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INTO THE START CONCERNING KEEPING DA FAITH LEFT THE RESULTS UNCHANGED.
