Footnotes

BRIGHT PICK, always in touch, angled out while closing on the turn, bid four-wide upper stretch and drove clear. SKEWED hopped a bit at the start, stalked from between horses, chased late turn and challenged upper stretch but was no match for the winner. LEWICKI led early, set the pace, was engaged upper stretch and yielded. TWENTY CENT PIECE raced off the pace, was hustled on the turn but never reached contention. COUNTY DREAMER stalked along the rail, was hustled into the stretch then flattened out. STREATERVILLE trailed four-wide then three-wide on the turn, lacked a strong closing response.
