FAVORITE SOUP, well back early, closed late turn, rallied five-wide, went by in deep stretch and finished under a hand ride. PORT STANLEY raced off the pace, angled out four-wide hustling late turn, was all out in the stretch but was outkicked in the final furlong. DUTCH STRIKER set a reserved pace, was pressured on the far turn, shook clear at the top of the stretch then gave way in the final furlong. THORNWOOD ROAD stalked the pace, lapped on to the leader through the far turn but gave way nearing the top of the stretch. PORTER'S GATE raced off the pace, closed into the far turn, forced the issue three-wide then tired in the stretch. HAWK ON THE HUNT raced off the pace, gained contention early on the final turn, chased late turn then tired in the stretch. DON VALENTINO, always well back, lacked a rally. FUNNY PECULIER pressed the pace under strong restraint, settled on the backstretch then faded through the turn.
