Footnotes

BACHELOR BLUES set a pressured pace from off the rail while under restraint, drew clear at the eleven sixteenths pole, came five wide into the stretch, and lasted. VICTORY LIGHT stalked the pace four wide, came seven wide into the stretch, rallied while drifting in and just missed. COMMENDATION was four wide early, three wide on the turn, angled in midway on the turn, rallied mildly off the rail in the stretch. AMERICA AMERICA broke outwards, trailed while off the rail, was three wide on the turn, gained mildly eight wide in the stretch. GRAND HERITAGE was reluctant to load, pressed the pace inside of the winner, weakened into the stretch. BON MARIE stalked the pace from off the rail, came out six wide in the stretch, and lost ground. DYNAFIRE was well placed inside, and had no menace. SPIDER CANYON stalked the pace three wide, dropped back in the stretch. GO KITTY GO raced three wide, was four wide on the turn and showed little. ZAKOCITY hit the gate at the start, was between horses and steadied in the backstretch, three wide on the turn, checked at the three eighths pole, faded in the stretch. A Stewards' inquiry following the race looking into the turn disqualified COMMENDATION from third and place him tenth for interfering with ZACKOCITY.
