PIPERS TRICK stalked the pace from the inside, advanced three wide, gained command at the quarter pole, turned back a bid from the runner up into the stretch and drew off. RUBY MIST stalked the pace three wide, made a bid outside the winner into the stretch, and was second best. SHE NUIT ALL bumped and steadied on the first turn, stalked the pace from off the rail, pressed outside ZELMIRA at the nine sixteenths pole, gained the lead briefly at the three eighths pole, then gave way. REGENTLY BOLD bobbed at the start, was well back inside, rallied mildly four wide. SANDERLING trailed early, came off the rail in the backstretch, advanced mildly three wide on the second turn, flattened out in the stretch. BELLE DE NASKRA raced four wide and was not a factor. HEAVENS PASSPORT raced inside, steadied on the first turn, stalked the pace from off the rail in the backstretch, made a mild bid three wide late in the backstretch, and dropped back. ZELMIRA was hustled to the lead, bumped on the first turn, cleared into the backstretch and moved to the rail, came under pressure at the nine sixteenths pole, gave way on the second turn and faded.
