QUICK SPLIT, under strong rating early, closed four-wide into the far turn, bid near the 1/4 pole, dueled, then drove clear in deep stretch. BLINDSIDEHIT stalked the pace, closed three-wide into the far turn, dueled, was headed midstretch and finished gamely to save the place. POWERFUL SARAH raced in midpack, chased five-wide late turn then rallied outside. JOHAR MOON, always prominent, dueled on the far turn, was passed by the winner in the final 16th and gave way. WISEHER settled off the pace, was hustled three-wide into the far turn, chased to the stretch and evened out. AFRICAN JAZZ, rank at the start, moved up quickly and vied on the first turn, pressed the pacesetter on the backstretch, chased from the rail on the turn then evened out. TITANIUM JANE stalked the pace, chased on the turn then flattened out in the stretch.
