KAY'S GRACE broke alertly, was headed entering the main track, forced the pace, dueled on the turn while racing four and five-wide, gained the lead upper stretch then drove clear and finished under a hand ride. HURRICANE LORRAINE, bumped at the start, was in range on the turn, failed with a bid between rivals upper stretch but finished best of the rest. VERY DRY DANCER raced in midpack, chased four-wide on the turn but failed to menace. HOBNOBSNOB led onto the main track, dueled through the turn, was hustled hard into the stretch and tired. MAHOGANY ROAD broke outward and bumped with a rival, settled off the pace, was hustled two and three-wide on the turn then evened out in the stretch. COMTESSE CRIMSON stalked the pace, chased four and five-wide on the turn then evened out in the final furlong. BEARAVIE settled well off the pace, chased four to six-wide on the turn then evened out. ON WE GO settled off the pace, was hustled two to four-wide through the turn and never reached contention.
