Footnotes

TUFF CHICK was allowed to settle between horses in the early going, split horses on the turn and roused three wide, hesitated slightly in the drive when NO CHEATING came out into her path, but continued strong to the wire and got up in the final strides. The latter was unhurried early inside of rivals, angled between horses on the turn and assumed command in the stretch, shied from left handed urging in the drive and bore out into the winner, opened a clear lead in the final furlong, but was outfinished. SHOOT TO KILL raced close up outside of rivals, roused on the turn, but never rallied and was never a threat. EBONY COUNTESS bore out at the start, but recovered quickly and pressed the early pace inside, assumed command in upper stretch, but failed to sustain the bid. SHINE FOR US was void of early speed outside of rivals, made a mild bid four wide on the turn, then flattened out in the drive. TRICKY MOMENT pressed the early pace three wide, then tired in the stretch. AMY'S BELIEVER was allowed to settle inside of rivals while off the rail, angled in on the turn, and finished with a mild bid. CAT ON A ROOF sped to the early lead and set the early pace, drew clear on the turn, then stopped in upper stretch. HARRIKANAW was shut off at the start and unhurried early between horses, never rallied and was never a factor.
