Footnotes

REASON FOR JUSTICE was well rated inside of rivals on a short lead, shook loose and drew clear in upper stretch, came to the wire all out and just lasted. EXPRESSO LOVE was off slowly and slow early, swung four wide entering the stretch and closed fast. SHARIDE stalked the early pace inside of rivals, angled out at the quarter pole and lost ground entering the stretch, then closed the gap in the late going. QUEEN SPEECH dueled for the early lead outside of rivals, then weakened in the stretch. DIVINE ROCKETTE settled in the second flight four wide and was never a threat. MIND READER hopped at the start, but recovered quickly and raced close up between horses in the early going, but never rallied and dropped back on the turn. LIFE'S BLESSING was close up between horses, then dropped back in the stretch. FAR AND NEAR was unhurried early outside of rivals and outrun.
