SO LONG GEORGE, always in striking range, chased hard four-wide on the far turn, responded smartly, gained steadily under an all out stretch drive and got up late. SPECIAL SELECTION led quickly, was pressured on the backstretch and far turn, shook clear at the top of the stretch, was under steady handling through the final furlong but failed to hold nearing the wire. ROCKINMEBABY stalked the pace, chased three and four-wide on the final turn, loomed dangerous at the top of the stretch, chased hard but evened out. JOHNNY LA RUE, rated off the pace, chased three and four-wide on the far turn but never reached contention. HAD TO HAPPEN settled off the pace, saved ground throughout, was hustled on the far turn but tired in the stretch. GOT YOU COVERED stalked the pacesetter on the clubhouse turn, forced the issue on the backstretch, lapped on to the leader entering the far turn but gave way near the 1/4 pole and tired.
