GONETOFARR pressed the early pace inside of rivals, roused in upper stretch and responded well prevailing along the rail. WHAT A BREEZE was shuffled back at the start and dropped back well off the lead, roused in the two path in the turn and closed with a rush in the drive getting up for place. WYNYARD broke sharply and was in hand on a short lead, weakened in the final furlong and gave way. PETITE CHATTE was unhurried early in the two path, roused on the turn and found his best stride in the late going. CLAIRLYN was hustled along chasing the early leaders from the two path, then got tired and stopped quickly in the final sixteenth. DYNACO was allowed to settle along the rail and never rallied. LALKA was unhurried early off the rail and lacked a late response. AMERICAN MONEY showed little and was never a factor. CARTIER was under left handed urging in the backstretch, then dropped back on the turn.
