Footnotes

SKEPTICAL pressed the pace while inside, led off the rail into the final furlong and was clear to the wire. GOLD NUGGET well back in the early going, closed ground and then bid inside in the stretch run to finish with good energy. DEJECTED in touch while inside on the turn, angled out then evened out in the final furlong. CRYSTAL DREAMER in striking distance and in the six path into the stretch, lacked the needed kick. COOP'S BEST BET had speed and was battling outside of rival into the turn, kept in the fracas into the stretch then tired. TAKE IT AND GO bumped at the break, raced off the pace then wide into the stretch but lacked the needed rally. BUCK HUNTER backed away into the turn and faded.
