LONESOME CHEROKEE backed off after pressing outside on the turn then came again in a game second effort. MO STAR off the pace then widest turning for home, did not menace. MOLINARO HANDSOME had an outside trip while keeping in touch into the turn then tired. SHY FOX in the early mix and in the hunt, was off the pace on the turn and faded.
