Footnotes

SURGE POWER raced in midpack, closed late turn, bid in the final furlong, drove clear and held under steady pressure. RIBOT SUN, rated in range, was roused two-wide at the top of the stretch, responded gamely then rallied determinedly, but missed. TAKE A PITCH, off a step slowly, raced in midpack, came three to five-wide through the turn, chased hard into the stretch and rallied outside. BRITE SAMMY raced forwardly, forced the pace late backstretch, chased on the turn then finished all out. UNCATCHABLE FIRE stalked the pace, took command late backstretch, set the pace, was clear at the top of the stretch but was caught just into the final furlong and gave way. OIL BE CLEVER raced forwardly, was headed late backstretch, chased up close on the turn then tired in the stretch. AUTHENTIC POWER, well back early, was hustled along the rail leaving the turn but never reached contention. HIGH JUMPER raced off the pace, came four to seven-wide through the far turn, chased into the stretch but never reached contention. MOLINARO DEPARTURE stalked the pace, raced four-wide through the far turn then evened out in the stretch. ORIENTAL GIFT, off slowly, raced well back, came three to six-wide through

the far turn then lacked a serious rally. WIDMO, in midpack early, dropped back gradually from late backstretch and lacked a rally. DOC FROST, in range to late turn, faded six-wide.
