MEMORIES LAST LOVE settled in midpack, was hustled five-wide on the turn, responded smartly upper stretch, rallied and was up late under a drive. SUMMER ENDING settled off the pace, saved ground, chased into the stretch, angled out sharply and rallied gamely. MISS SCARLETT ROAD stalked early, forced the issue into the turn, took command late turn but failed to hold in deep stretch. ASHIGHASTHEHEAVENS, off slowly, settled off the pace, chased hard four and five-wide on the turn then gained steadily through the stretch. EXECUTIVE DRIVEN stalked the pace, chased four-wide on the turn then evened out in deep stretch. WHISKEY ROMANCE, well back early, was hustled three and four-wide on the turn then rallied belatedly. SOAP OPERA STAR, off slowly, stalked the pace, chased on the turn then evened out in the late stages. OLIVIA'S SONG, in range, was hustled five-wide on the turn then evened out midstretch. WHITE ROAD moved up to take a clear early lead, was pressured on the turn then headed approaching the top of the stretch, chased to the final 16th and tired. TOTAL BLISS stalked the pace, dropped back nearing the turn, was hustled along then tired in the stretch.
