YOUNG DUDE raced in midpack, closed five-wide late turn, led briefly in deep stretch and was passed. MURRAYS IN A HURRY gained a short lead on the backstretch, was headed and stalked the pace two and three-wide, bid upper stretch, led to the late stages and was headed. WHERE'S JOHNSON, jostled at the start, gained command, was clear on the turn but was headed a furlong out and gave way. DO THE MATH raced in midpack, closed into the turn, stalked four and five-wide, chased into the stretch then flattened out. BATHSHEBA STATION was jostled leaving, rated off the pace, chased late turn, came six-wide into the stretch and failed to menace. CANDY BULL raced in midpack, was hustled on the turn, chased into the stretch and evened out late. TARDY chased along the rail, was in range on the turn but itred in the final furlong. MATTER OF TRUTH, jostled at the start, was shuffled back early turn, then checked behind rivals late turn and lacked a rally. SENOR RED moved up to up to duel on the backstretch, was quickly headed and faded gradually between foes. FATHOM'S END, in touch, was hustled between rivals on the turn then tired in the stretch.
