SUNSHINE PROMISE pressed the pace on the backstretch, forced the issue on the turn, chased in the stretch and got by late then held under a drive. CAFE AU LAIT raced in midpack, was hustled three-wide late turn and finished all out. CIBOULETTE settled in midpack, was hustled on the turn then rallied determinedly along the rail. OUR DARRILYN led early, set a pressured pace in hand, had a clear lead in the stretch but failed to stay in the late stages. TURN TO SHINE raced off the pace, chased three to five-wide on the turn then rallied belatedly outside rivals. I'LLTHINKABOUTIT raced in midpack, chased late turn then flattened out in deep stretch. BEEZIE stalked the pace, chased hard five-wide late turn then tired midstretch. IS IT COOL, off slowly, settled off the pace, was hustled two to four-wide through the turn then flattened out in the stretch. WHERE OH WHERE bolted outward early as she neared the gap, unseated her rider and jumped the fence.
