Footnotes

LOVE A RUCKUS was allowed to settle between horses, raced four wide on the turn, but was in tight and steadied, assumed command entering the stretch and drew clear, but was tiring in the late going and was all out approaching the wire. BRANKSOME HALL was unhurried early inside of rivals, closed the gap four wide entering the stretch and finished well, but belatedly. DANCE FOR OLGA raced close up three wide in the early going, but was between horses in the stretch and checked, then angled out in the last furlong and finished well outside of rivals. RUBY PARK was allowed to settle off the rail, closed the gap five wide on the turn and closed the gap entering the stretch, but flattened out at the end. AMY'S BELIEVER chased the early leader three wide, then weakened in the stretch. FOUND TREASURE was void of early speed, angled out in upper stretch and made a mild bid, but was never a threat. PRINCESS RUCKUS set the early pace unchallenged, but gave way in upper stretch and dropped back. PROSPECTIVE GAL stalked the early pace inside of rivals, but failed to respond and dropped back in the drive. DELI CAT was void of early speed and never rallied.
