CONVOY BOY, in range, closed late turn, bid at the top of the stretch and drove clear then widened, driving. TWICE WILD showed three-wide speed, dropped back nearing the turn, stalked the pace then finished all out. CALM NIGHT raced midpack, was hustled four and five-wide on the turn and was all out in the stretch. ENGLISH ALPHABET raced midpack, was hustled between rivals on the turn, chased into the stretch but evened out in the late stages. SUNNY SQUALL raced forwardly, gained a short lead on the turn, was headed upper stretch, could not match strides and tired. SLEW'S KID raced off the pace, angled from three to five-wide on the turn but never reached contention. VICTORY FOR TESSA, in range, saved ground but flattened out in the stretch. DADDY'S MISSILE raced off the pace, was hustled through the turn, came four-wide to the top of the stretch, was roused but had no response. B

SHARP raced off the pace, angled three to six-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch but never threatened. WATERCOLORMEMORIES broke alertly, stalked the pace then tired in the stretch. HIGH SPEED raced midpack, saved ground but lacked a rally. READY TO BE KISSED settled off the pace, angled from the rail to four-wide on the turn then lacked a closing response. FEISTY CLYDE had speed between horses, forced the pace on the turn then tired at the top of the stretch.
