HANDY HAROLD raced off the pace, closed along the rail on the backstretch, moved between rivals and stalked on the turn, challenged in the final furlong and moved clear under a hand ride. JEBSTER stalked the pace, came four to six-wide through the far turn, chased into the stretch and finished gamely. PINDERS GAP took command entering the backstretch, set a pressured pace, was swarmed late turn and was headed at the top of the stretch but was game to the end. STOLONBOY, in range between rivals, was hustled three to five-wide on the far turn then evened out in deep stretch. MIGHTY MONARCH stalked the pace early then pressed on the backstretch, bid late turn, led at the top of the stretch but gave way in the final furlong. TAIERI RIVER raced off the pace, closed inside rivals late turn and was all out through the stretch. BULLONTHEWIRE raced in midpack, was hustled four-wide into the stretch, angled to the rail and rallied gamely. POINT TUPPER raced in midpack, was hustled three-wide late turn then finished evenly. MAPLE TINTS showed early speed, was headed entering the backstretch, forced the pace then tired upper stretch. MAMMA'S KNIGHT, rated off the pace, closed six-wide late turn but never reached contention. QUINZEE broke outward, raced in midpack, chased hard five-wide to seven-wide on the far turn then tired in the late stages. NEW YORK HOLIDAY, off a step slowly, raced in midpack, came four and five-wide through the far turn, was hustled along then lacked a rally. ARTIE HOT broke in the air, raced off the pace, chased four to seven-wide on the far turn then evened out in the stretch. SOMARVELOUS raced off the pace, angled five to eight-wide through the final turn then lacked a closing response.
