HARLAN'S PANTHER, rated off the pace, closed angling from three to five-wide on the far turn, rallied gamely and got up late under a drive. PULPATION, away alertly, was headed and stalked the pace well in hand, chased two-wide to four-wide on the far turn, bid in deep stretch and drove to a narrow advantage but was outfinished. KIAMA, under strong rating early, bid midway of the backstretch, led into the far turn and was clear, set the pace, was under a drive in the stretch but tired in the late stages. OUR TRUE GAL, rated off the pace from the second path, chased into the stretch and finished all out. WILL TO SHINE broke inward, set a reserved pace, was joined on midbackstretch, chased on the turn and finished all out. BEWITCHING LADY ducked out entering the first turn, moved inward a bit and stalked the pace under strong rating, gave way on the far turn and lacked a rally. AWFULLY SINFUL, rated off the pace, saved ground, was roused at the top of the stretch but showed no response.
