FULL OF WISDOM moved up to stalk from the rail late backstretch, chased two-wide on the turn, bid along the rail upper stretch and shook clear then held under a drive. SILENT KNIGHT, well back early, was hustled four-wide on the far turn, came seven-wide into the stretch, rallied and was gaining late. SHANGHAI KNIGHT raced off the pace, closed five then six-wide on the far turn and was under an all out drive through the stretch. KNIGHT'S QUEST, in range, chased two-wide late turn, was blocked near the 1/8 pole, angled out and rallied gamely. PIRATE'S LEGEND briefly forced the pace, dropped back on the backstretch, was hustled four-wide through the turn then lacked a rally. TANNERS CROSSING set a pressured pace, vied briefly on the backstretch and was headed, rebid into the turn, dueled to upper stretch then tired midstretch. HAT TRICK KID, off a step slowly, closed along the rail on the first turn, joined the leader early backstretch, gained a short lead, was engaged in a duel through the far turn, was headed a furlong out and tired. DIPLOMATIC IMPACT raced midpack, closed four-wide on the far turn, chased to upper stretch then evened out. SPRY CAT stalked close up early, was hustled four-wide late turn then tired in the final furlong. I'M A LITTLE FISH raced midpack between foes, chased along the second path, moved to the rail on the turn then tired in the stretch. HIGHLAN CREEK settled well back early, was hustled on the far turn, came six-wide to the top of the stretch then lacked a closing

response. DOWN BY THE DOCKS, in range early, faded on the backstretch then showed no response on the far turn.
