HAWKSLEY HILL (IRE) was unhurried early just off the rail, swung wide entering the stretch and closed with a rush getting up in the final strides but the jockey hit JIM AND TONIC (FR) with the whip in the final strides. QUIET RESOLVE was away alertly then taken in hand and stalked the early pace, drew even four wide in upper stretch and battled gamely but was outfinished. ROB 'N GIN showed good early speed and was unchallenged on a clear lead, dueled inside of rivals in the drive and just failed in a game effort. JIM AND TONIC (FR) was in hand three wide in the early going, roused five wide in the drive, went between horses in the final furlong but was in tight and hit by rival's whip but battled gamely and finished well. SILIC (FR) was allowed to settle

along the rail, roused just off the rail in the drive and finished with a mild bid. CAPE CROSS (IRE) was unhurried early between horses and was close up then weakened in the late going. POTEEN was void of early speed between horses, roused off the rail in upper stretch and finished with a mild rally. GARBU was in hand stalking the early pace from the rail but failed to respond in the drive and dropped back. INCITATUS (BAR) was unhurried early along the rail, angled out around the turn and made a mild bid but was never a threat. BOMFIM was close up between horses in the early going then tired in the drive and dropped back. LONESOME DUDE was unhurried early inside of rivals, saved ground through the turn and improved his position in the drive but was never a threat. LORD SMITH (GB) was close up between horses in the backstretch but lacked a late response. KARRA KUL was unhurried early in the three path and never rallied. CHARGE D'AFFAIRES (GB) settled along the rail in the early going, moved close up entering the drive but tired in the late going. SKY COLONY was void of early speed and outrun. The jockey of JIM AND TONIC (FR) lodged a claim of foul against the jockey of HAWKSLEY HILL (IRE) for possible interference in the run through the stretch. HAWKSLEY HILL (IRE) was disqualified from the win position and placed fourth for hitting JIM AND TONIC (FR) with the whip during the drive.
