VIRGINIA PLAIN raced midpack, closed four-wide on the turn, gained steadily in the stretch and got up late. RINGLET pressed the pace from the inside, bid at the top of the stretch and drove clear then failed to hold the winner safe. WHAT'S YOUR POINT was close three-wide, chased on the turn then evened out in the stretch. GLORY AND FAITH well back early, was roused between horses late turn but showed too little response to menace. PUSSYCAT PUSSYCAT was close early between rivals, was hard-ridden from the 1/4 pole but failed to threaten. FIREBABY dueled early, took a short lead on the turn, was under pressure then could not stave off the winner at the top of the stretch and gave way. EVIL EMPRESS steadied slightly at the start, raced well off the pace then never reached contention. STORMY KRISTINE raced on the rail and lacked a rally. NUSHKA was close early but faded on the rail through the turn.
