Footnotes

DUBLEO paired up with TOMMEY'S TOPPER early, drew clear entering the turn, set a reserved pace then held sway under steady pressure through the stretch. DANCE WITH RAVENS was unhurried early, closed three-wide on the turn then was all out in the stretch to no avail. GO TO THE SUN was well back early on the inside, closed between horses on the turn then evened out in the stretch. STRIKE A BARGAIN was unhurried along the hedge, closed on the turn, was in tight upper stretch then evened out. STAG NATION broke in the air and raced well off the pace, advanced three-wide on the turn then finished evenly. COPYCO was well off the early pace, raced three-wide then lacked a closing response. ELUSIVE THUNDER broke outward, raced well back and was never a serious factor. TOMMY'S TOPPER broke in the air but sprinted to the lead, was joined early by DUBLEO, remained outside that one to the turn, stalked from between rivals to the stretch and tired. AN OBJECTION BY THE RIDER ON STRIKE A BARGAIN AGAINST GO TO THE SUN FOR INTERFERENCE UPPERSTRETCH WAS DISALLOWED.
