AWESOME RHYTHM, in range, dropped back on the backstretch, closed five-wide late turn, rallied gamely and went by late under a drive. DUMBLEDORE stalked the pace, bid midway of the far turn, dueled, shook clear a furlong out but fail to hold the winner safe in deep stretch. MAMMA'S KNIGHT raced off the pace, closed angling from the rail to five-wide late turn, was all out through the stretch but did not threaten. GONE TRAJECTOR Y led early, was headed late on the first turn, stalked the leader, rebid along the rail into the far turn, vied, then yielded a furlong out. CAMBRIDGE BLUE, rated off the pace, saved ground, was hustled late turn but was not a threat. STOLONBOY hopped at the start, raced off the pace, was roused late turn but showed no serious response. LIBIAMO hopped at the start, circled the field and took command leaving the first turn, set the pace, was joined at the far turn, dueled to midturn and tired.
