TIN PAN ALLEY CAT raced off the pace, closed three-wide late turn, launched an all out rally, gained steadily and swept by in deep stretch. WHAT A PRINCE led early, set a reserved pace, quickened into the stretch but failed to hold the winner safe. MOVIE ROCK stalked the pace, was hustled three-wide after the leader late turn and finished determinedly. PALMERS, in range, chased along the rail late turn but flattened out midstretch. GLADWYNE raced well back, chased hard late turn but never reached contention. SAY NO EVIL raced in midpack, was hustled angling from three to five-wide on the turn but never threatened. CELERITY'S SUMMIT, in range along the second path, lacked a closing response. BERNARD TERRACE raced off the pace, was hustled late turn then flattened out in the final furlong.
