Footnotes

BLACK MINK set the pace well in hand, quickened late turn and held sway under a drive. FAVORITE FANTASY raced off the pace, closed four then five-wide on the turn and rallied willingly outside. MISS OLIE raced midpack, was hustled along the rail late turn and rallied gamely. ROYAL MAGENTA stalked the pace, pressed on the turn, was all out in the stretch but evened out late. KNOTTY KAT trailed along the rail, angled out closing late turn and rallied belatedly. LA GRAN GERMAINE raced off the pace two-deep, angled five-wide leaving the turn then showed a mild rally. LA BONITA UNO raced midpack three-wide, was hustled four-wide into the stretch but lacked a strong closing response. HOURS APART stalked from the rail, chased into the

stretch, angled out a bit but evened out. FLOWER BELLE LEE raced midpack, came three and four-wide through the turn then lacked a rally. BIDONMEBABY, well back early, saved ground, closed into the stretch but failed to threaten. BLIND RAGE, in range, dropped back on the turn, moved to the rail at the top of the stretch but lacked a late response. ABIRA, in range between rivals, flattened out in the stretch. CREEKSIDE CAFE, in range, was hustled late turn and tired in the stretch.
