GO WEST G T GO raced off the pace, was hustled three-wide on the turn, got up to bid midstretch and prevailed under a drive. LUNAR LINDA stalked from the rail, angled out between horses late turn, was blocked a furlong out then rallied gamely when clear and just missed. SUNSET PLEASURE set a pressured pace, was engaged late turn, vied into the stretch then gave way grudgingly. D' COUNTRY pressed the pace, was hustled into the stretch, finished determinedly and missed. SHEILA'S SNOWSHOE, rated off the pace, was hustled four-wide late turn, finished gamely but needed more. PLAY ON WORDS, up close three-wide, bid late turn, dueled into the stretch and gave way. STILL LEARNING, up close early, was hustled along the rail late turn, launched an inside bid at the top of the stretch, failed to match strides and tired. CHISPA raced off the pace, was hustled late turn but never reached contention. HERECOMESHANNA raced off the pace, was hustled four-wide on the turn then tired in the stretch.
