GALLOPING D'AMOUR raced off the pace, closed four-wide on the turn, bid upper stretch, dueled briefly and drove clear in the final furlong. HOLD THAT ECHO settled off the pace, chased three to six-wide on the turn then rallied gamely. NAME IN LIGHTS set a reserved pace, was engaged late backstretch but gained a short lead entering the turn, was pressured to the stretch, engaged again upper stretch and yielded in the final furlong. SHE WANTS, in range, chased late turn then finished determinedly between rivals. BEDARRA raced in midpack, chased three-wide into the stretch then evened out in the late stages. EXECUTIVE BONNIE, off a step slowly, closed on the backstretch, chased from the rail on the turn, failed with a bid at the head of the stretch and flattened out. RIDE THE BULLET stalked the pace, offered a brief bid late backstretch, forced the pace on the turn then tired at the top of the stretch. CERTAIN PRIDE raced off the pace and trailed.
