FOURTEES forced the pace, bid into the turn, dueled, shook clear at the top of the stretch and held sway under a strong hand ride. ITS A GIZMO was sent to a short early lead, was headed at the turn, chased to the stretch and finished under a determined drive. I'M GOOD WITH IT broke outward, stalked the pace, was hustled on the turn then rallied late outside. EVERY PENNY COUNTS, bothered at the start, chased from midpack then tendered a strong late rally between foes. ISABEL MIST settled in midpack, saved ground, chased late turn then finished evenly along the rail. AMIRA'S PRIDE forced the issue, bid into the turn, dueled, was headed at the top of the stretch and gave way. AISLE ALTAR HYMN raced in midpack, chased four to six-wide on the turn but never reached contention. FIDDLELINA settled off the pace, moved over to the rail, saved ground through the turn but lacked a rally. VOUKEFALAS settled off the pace, was hustled on the turn then tired in the stretch.
