CRY WAR EAGLE settled off the pace, closed outside rivals late backstretch, chased four-wide into the turn, took the lead in the final furlong and drew clear under light handling. INCLUSA raced in midpack, was hustled late turn and chased to the wire. WELL EXECUTED raced off the pace, was hustled angling from two to four-wide on the turn then chased through the stretch. LEESON STREET LADY was sent to the early lead, set a reserved pace, was hustled into the stretch, was caught in the final furlong and tired. QUINTE WEST, rated off the pace, was hustled on the turn but never reached contention. ENGLISH CROSSING raced off the pace, chased hard five-wide late turn then evened out in the stretch. WHY KATHERINE stalked the pace, chased from the rail on the turn but tired in the late stages.
