CAFE ELEKTRIK (GB) stalked the pace, was hustled three and four-wide on the turn, bid midstretch and prevailed under a hand ride. SHELDONS CRUSADER forced the pace in the early going, chased on the turn, bid midstretch and was outfinished. MAY FOURTEEN forced the issue, dueled on the turn, shook clear into the stretch, was headed midstretch and yielded grudgingly. ROYAL GREATNESS raced in midpack, closed four-wide late turn then rallied outside. ONE WORD set a pressured pace, dueled on the turn, was headed at the top of the stretch, chased, then evened out in the final 16th. SANGORE, well back early, was hustled on the turn but never reached contention. OCALA SON, away late, was hustled on the turn but lacked a rally. BUFFALO STORM bumped with EL GRAYLING at the start, settled well back, was hustled on the turn but was never in contention. EL GRAYLING bumped with BUFFALO STORM, raced well off the pace, saved ground but was never a threat. TOCCET MAN stalked the pace, chased hard on the turn then tired in the stretch. A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INTO THE START OF THE RACE FOUND THAT OCALA SON HAD RECEIVED AN UNFAIR START NECESSITATING A REFUND.
