STAKES Overskate S. Black Type - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD, Sired by a Stallion standing in Ontario for his entire season the year of conception and registered with the Canadian Thoroughbred Horse Society for that season.

(No Canadian Bred Allowance.) Final entries to be made through the entry box at the closing time then in effect for overnight events. A supplemental nomination may be made no later than the time of final entry, by a non-refundable fee of \$2,500, which includes the entry fee. (Closed with 12 Nominations and 1 Supplement) * Plus up to \$10,200 Ontario Sired/Ontario Bred Breeder Awards. \$95,000 of this purse has been provided through the Thoroughbred Improvement Program.

BEAR'S PEAK pulled to contention on the backstretch, stalked three and four-wide on the turn, launched a determined stretch drive and got by late under a strong hand ride. JENNA'S WABBIT pressed the pace in hand, took command upper stretch but failed to hold in the late stages. COURTVILLE, rated off the pace, was hustled three and four-wide on the turn then rallied gamely. BUG'S BOY, in touch between foes, chased three-wide into the stretch and finished all out. FORESTADOR, rated off the pace, was hustled four and five-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch then rallied outside. CITIUS, in touch between horses, was shuffled back at the turn, remained in hand between foes to the stretch then rallied belatedly. MOBIL UNIT, away slowly, settled off the pace, closed on the turn then evened out late between foes. SODA ON THE SIDE settled off the pace, was roused strongly five-wide late turn but evened out in the stretch. ROYAL EGBERT broke inward, gained a short lead, set a pressured pace, was headed upper stretch and tired along the rail. WELLOILEDMACHINE, squeezed back just out of the gate, moved up to stalk the pace near the turn, chased along the rail then flattened out in the stretch.
